



ICD-10 for Claims Search in PPE

What's Changing

The U. S. Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) has finalized the adoption of the International Classification of Diseases – 10th Revision (ICD-10) code set, which will replace the current ICD-9 codes as of October 1, 2015. The new code set contains 5 times as many codes as ICD-9.

This means that when using the Claims Search, users will be able to search by ICD-9 and ICD-10 codes to return the correct procedure set. An ICD-9 code may either have an exact ICD-10 equivalent or multiple possibilities for more specific ICD-10 codes. If there is more than one ICD-10 code, a crosswalk mapping tool will allow the user to select the appropriate codes.

This functionality will be enabled on September 24, 2015 to allow for client testing and practice.

1:1 Match

In cases where there is an exact match from the old ICD-9 code to the new equivalent ICD-10 code, the ICD-10 code will be listed under the description and diagnosis columns of the search results screen.
