Because the new edits will be applied on a pre-adjudication basis, an increase in the number of claim rejections may occur. This will enable UnitedHealthcare claim submitters to identify and correct rejected information prior to the claim's acceptance into our adjudication system for processing. The benefit for providers will be fewer denied claims and less interruption to revenue streams.
